

MAJOR CONVENTION FACILITIES

Portland's convention facilities' award-winning architectural designs visually and symbolically represent the heart of the city. Innovative features combined with practical, user-friendly floor plans make any group feel welcome.

OREGON CONVENTION CENTER (OCC)

The Pacific Northwest's premier meeting space, the Oregon Convention Center is known for its architectural beauty, functionality and friendly, service-oriented staff. The OCC footprint covers nearly one million square feet, with 255,000 square feet of contiguous pillar-free exhibit space (12,000 seats theater style; 1,300 10'x10' booths). Other features include:

- 30 feet on center floor boxes
- 350-pound-per-square-foot floor load capacity
- 20 rear-access loading docks
- 50 meeting rooms totaling 55,000 square feet
- Two ballrooms totaling 60,000 square feet
- Fully equipped kitchen to serve up to 10,000 delegates
- 120,000-square-foot lobby spaces throughout the facility
- 800 underground parking spaces
- Food services provided by ARAMARK/Giacometti Partners, Ltd.

The OCC is conveniently and centrally located on the east bank of the Willamette River, one block southeast of the Rose Quarter complex. It is adjacent to Interstate 5 and five blocks west of Lloyd Center shopping mall. The OCC has its own MAX light rail stop. www.oregoncc.org

ROSE QUARTER

Consisting of the Rose Garden arena, Memorial Coliseum and the Rose Quarter Commons, the Rose Quarter complex is located on the east bank of the Willamette River, one block northwest of the Oregon Convention Center, alongside Interstate 5 and adjacent to the MAX light rail. Opened in 1995, this urban entertainment complex is unparalleled in America. Food service throughout the Rose Quarter is provided by Ovations Food Services. www.rosequarter.com

ROSE GARDEN ARENA

Designed for professional basketball and hockey competitions, the Rose Garden offers 21,300 seats, 70 luxury suites and a variety of banquet and reception options. Home to the NBA's Portland Trail Blazers, the Rose Garden arena is also hosts concerts, ice shows and more.

MEMORIAL COLISEUM

The home arena for the Portland Winter Hawks (WHL), the Memorial Coliseum seats 12,888 people and offers 13,300 square feet of meeting space, a 25,000-square-foot concourse and 48,000 square feet of dedicated exhibition space.

ROSE QUARTER COMMONS

The Rose Quarter Commons is an outdoor plaza that connects the Rose Garden arena, the Memorial Coliseum and their attending parking structures (2,500-vehicle capacity). At 125,000 square feet (nearly 3 acres), the Commons is Portland's largest outdoor public plaza. It features Essential Forces, a kinetic water-and-fire feature with 500 water jets. The Commons is available for outdoor concerts and receptions.

ADDITIONAL CONVENTION FACILITIES

PORTLAND METROPOLITAN EXPOSITION CENTER

The Expo Center is the largest consumer show facility in Oregon, with more than 330,000 square feet of exhibit space in six contiguous halls, lobby and reception areas, meeting and show manager rooms and 3,000 on-site parking spaces. Food service is provided by ARAMARK/Giacometti Partners, Ltd.

The Expo Center is located four miles north of downtown on the west side of Interstate 5, at the center of Delta Park Recreation Area, immediately south of Hayden Island. It can be accessed by MAX light rail.

UNIVERSITY OF PORTLAND CHILES CENTER

The University of Portland Chiles Center seats up to 5,500 people under a clear-span timber dome. Flexible seating arrangements can accommodate sporting events, concerts or meetings. The University of Portland campus offers dormitory-style housing with meeting rooms.

The campus is located four miles northwest of the Rose Quarter/Oregon Convention Center on North Willamette Boulevard. On-site food service is provided by the University of Portland.
