1BREAKSIDE · The brewery is known for its innovative, experimental and diverse beers. Breakside was named Brewery of the Year at the 2017 Oregon Beer Awards and the 2017 Best of Craft Beer Awards.

2 EXNOVO · Drink Beer. Do Good. Is their mantra. Beer has always done a great job of bringing people together and hatching great ideas, like the one to start a brewery that gives all its profits away. We wanted to form a brewery that respects the pedigree of brewing found in the NW crafting consistently enjoyable and unique beers.

3 HAIR OF THE DOG · founded with the purpose of providing beer lovers with new and unusual beer styles. Each beer has its own name and unique identity. They are dedicated to buying local products for both the Brewery and restaurant.

4 CASCADE BARREL HOUSE · Tart, barrelaged beers are the emerging beer style and Cascade Brewing is a pioneer of the Northwest sour beer movement. We are, by nature, the definition of artisanal brewing: we're not bound by stylistic guidelines, just our own imagination and the ingredients we can access.

5 MIGRATION BREWING · What they believe: We believe in sweat equity and doing it yourself. We live for sunny days on the patio. We are independent. We measure success one pint at a time. We give back. We love our neighborhood and city. Some of us are from here, some of us aren't. We believe in the power of beer, people and chasing dreams. We believe that great beer makes the journey.

6 BASE CAMP BREWING, founded in 2012, taps into two local passions: beer and the outdoors. They brew lagers, experimental styles and a famous S'mores Stout that comes with a toasted marshmallow right on the chalice. Base Camp's brews are bottled on-site in aluminum bottles, which are perfect for keeping beer cold and fresh on hikes, kayak trips and other adventures.

Gluten-free ale is the sole focus at **7 GROUND BREAKER BREWING**, which uses Willamette Valley chestnuts handroasted on-site to take the place of grains in their awardwinning brews. Taste gluten-free IPAs, pale and dark ales, as well as experimental ales incorporating local ingredients like coffee or squash, and enjoy gluten-free food at the Ground Breaker Gastropub next door.

Get your wing-fix while sipping at **8** FIRE ON THE MOUNTAIN. Since claiming best chicken wings this side of Buffalo, they decided to enter Portland's brewing gold rush. And while their brewery continues to grow, their mission remains the same: make outstanding beer for excellent people.
